Title: Post Owner Transactions

Path: \underline{O} wner Management \rightarrow Owner \underline{P} osting Tools \rightarrow \underline{P} ost Owner Transactions

Purpose: This is the best and fastest posting utility to use when dealing with a series of charges

that have something in common. There are two options:

Post Several Charges to a Contract
 After establishing the Unit number, it is retained on the posting form to speed entry of additional transactions.

Post a Charge to Several Contracts
 Upon selecting the transaction code and entering the appropriate posting details, the User is prompted for a Unit number. After pressing <Enter> to post the transaction the User is again prompted for another Unit number. All of the details from the first transaction are retained on the posting form to speed entry though all are editable to accommodate slight variations.

Best Practice:

Note that one of the fields within the posting form is labeled "Type" and accepts a 2-character code. Under most circumstances, this field would be left blank when creating postings. Structurally, this is understood as the "automated transaction type" and is normally out of sight to the User. Owner transactions that are created by the system have one of these codes that distinguish the posting from a manual one. While the system recognizes seven valid codes, only four of them should ever be entered by a User. They should only be added when a "missing" automated transaction is being added to a Contract folio:

- IC = INCOME nightly room revenue derived from an in-house reservation
- HC = COMMIS house commission based on an INCOME posting
- MP = Transaction codes that are part of an OMap in Special Billing on a reservation
- **HK** = Housekeeping charges from scheduled services and related to the (P)osting command on the Housekeeping Console

In each of these cases, the posting must be linked to the Reservation number to which it is related. There are a variety of reasons why one of these transactions may be missing but in each case the User is recreating the conditions of what should have been an automated posting on a particular date.

Note: Currently, only in-house (INH) reservations can be linked to the posting.
